



Mustard Leadership Internship Program

Program Overview

The *Mustard Leadership Internship Program* offers a combination of hands-on ministry experience and intentional leadership development. Interns will receive valuable experience in Christian ministry and the nonprofit sector while developing essential leadership skills through mentorship and practical application.

Program Structure

- **Duration:** 12+ months
- **Time Commitment:** 1-2 days per week (8-16 hours)
- **Compensation:** A bursary will be paid
- **Location:** Mustard Leadership offices (Kew) with occasional off-site ministry activities

What Interns Will Gain

- Understanding of not-for-profit operations and schools and youth ministry
- Practical leadership experience, including participation in visits to Youth Groups, Camps and School Lunchtime Groups, involvement in School Workshops and Chapel services and assistance in training and mentoring of Student Leaders.
- Regular leadership training sessions with Mustard Intern Coordinator
- Networking opportunities with ministry leaders

Learning Focus Areas

- Teamwork
- Communication and public speaking
- Event planning and execution
- Pastoral care and support for youth

Application Requirements

- Commitment to Mustard's mission and values
- Desire to grow in leadership capacity
- Availability to commit to a minimum of 8 hours a week, with one core day and flexibility for occasional other weekday or weekend hours
